Business Need

As early adopters of Voice over IP (VoIP), the *Daily Sun* newspaper group used a Hosted PBX delivered over high-speed Internet for several years. But when they changed locations, they discovered the connection was not providing their business with consistent quality.

"Newspapers have very specific data needs," said Adam Hirshan, publisher and owner. They needed customized routing and porting of the internal network, as well as connections to services outside their offices in order to access applications that store news stories and data. The group operates four locations in Laconia, Berlin and North Conway, New Hampshire; and Portland, Maine; which means they needed the ability to communicate high data traffic to the cloud and among their offices and the ability to remotely control work stations. They also relied heavily on the auto-attendant features of VoIP to relieve the pressure of call screening on their receptionist, freeing up valuable staff time.

"Being connected – to employees, customers, advertisers, etc. – through communications and data is the lifeblood of our business," said Adam. Every ad placed in the paper – the source of the *Daily Sun's* revenue – is delivered electronically; nine out of 10 of their business transactions are conducted by telephone or email; and all of news content is accessed via their online content management system.

"We were looking for a vendor with the right infrastructure to provide the connectivity for our VoIP system to work reliably," said Adam Hirshan.
